Urban Amenities in a Rural Environment- You're only a few minutes away from whatever you need in Mountain View County; home to first class educational and health facilities - including hospitals in Olds, Didsbury and Sundre. A number of urban and rural schools service the student population, with post-secondary opportunities available at the nationally renowned Olds College. The Position:

As the Manager of Assessment Services you will oversee a team of assessors and administrative professionals; coordinate and assist with the delivery, administration and annual valuation of properties within the County; manage and assist in the valuation of all industrial, commercial and residential properties in the County and the assessment of all mobile homes and the maintenance and updating of related records and notices. Duties involve the re-inspections and investigation and resolution of complaints regarding assessment; will represent the County at Assessment Review Board and Municipal Government Board hearings.
