



Accessing the M.I.M.A. Accreditation as an AAA member:

- 1. Validation of Good Standing in Home (originating) Jurisdiction
 - Applicant must provide a letter of good standing and proof of professional certification
- 2. Validation of Experience Requirement
 - Current resume and statements signed by department head/supervisor/HR certifying dates and working titles related to experience in the practice of assessment
- 3. Validation of Education Requirement
 - Copy of Assessment or Appraisal Program Completion or other property valuation training certification
- 4. Validation of IMA Pre-Requisites
 - Complementary access to the following courses to assist with local legislation
 - IMA-350: Ethical Guide for the Assessor
 - IMA-401: Legal Framework for Assessment in Ontario
 - IMA-412: Assessor in the Courts
 - IMA-402 Assessment Law in Newfoundland and Labrador
 - Legislative Knowledge Challenge Test
 - Oral Interview by IMA Examiners
